### Reason(s) for Refusal

The loss of the existing single glazed timber framed windows and their replacement with double glazed windows and the design of the replacement, featuring double-glazing and non-structural glazing bars, by reason of their detailed design and appearance, would represent unsympathetic and incongruous additions to the Grade II Listed building and wider listed terrace, disrupting its elevational composition and causing harm to its special historic and architectural significance, and would also cause harm to the character and appearance of the Jeffrey's Street Conservation Area, contrary to the aims of Policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
