People set up on the seating provided at this site and play loud music through the night, they have security operating through the night and should be able to move these people as it is their seating. Before this site was built we didn't have these issues along this side of the canal. The flats on the site are behind the railway line so are protected from the noise. If this site is allowed to operate till later the disturbance will affect health as it will make it impossible to sleep with noise intrusion, in summer we will not be able to leave windows open. If there is a restriction of no music to be played at all after 8pm and no music to be heard at any residential premises that should help.
