Although the arboriculture report recommends that they be felled, it is possible that the report is overly cautious as it has been commissioned by an insurer. I would like Camden to consider that pruning may be a viable alternative as the trees are distant from the property. We have already lost 2 sycamores in this green section in as many years (although these were very close to the houses) and I urge Camden planning to do all they can to preserve the biodiversity that is so important in our area. Camden are taking measures to reduce carbon emissions and need to extend this to ensure the preservation of our carbon reducing trees where-ever possible. These trees are a key amenity asset in this conservation area giving a green outlook at the rear of houses that face a busy urban environment, they reduce overlooking, light pollution and encourage wildlife. |
