is disruptive to the significance of the Listed Buildings.

4. We object to the insertion of uplights in the timber floor (first floor description). The insertion of downlighters in the ceilings is acknowledged to be unacceptable in disrupting the plane surfaces and sense of volume in listed buildings, and the same is true of uplighters which disrupt the floor surface which should be âreadâ as a plane, uninterrupted, surface helping to define the volume of the space.
