### **NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA**

Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 2 x Limes (T1 & T2) - Crown reduction back to most recent points leaving furnishing growth. Remove trunk growth to a height of 6m.

1 x Lime (T6) - Crown height reduction by 3m. Reduce crown spread by up to 2m - 2.5m to balance and shape.

1 x Sycamore (T7) - Thin crown by 20%. Remove 2-3 low branches to elevate weight.

4 x Sycamores (T8, T9, T10 & T11) - Crown reduction in height and spread back to previous points leaving furnishing growth.

1 x Sycamore (T12) - Crown reduction in height and spread back to previous points leaving furnishing growth. Replace the bracing.

1 x Sycamore (T15) - Crown thin by 15%.

1 x Birch (T16) - Crown thin by 20%.

1 x Willow (T17) - Crown reduction in height and spread back to previous points leaving furnishing growth. Install two new props.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 25 February 2022 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- 3 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife. Of particular note is the protection offered to bats, birds and their nests from construction works.
