The noise of workmen walking in the loft space which is not often at the moment sounds as though they are coming through my living room ceiling. At 128 the living rooms are at the front &amp; our bedrooms are at the back. The quality of life for my neighbours and I are at the moment &amp; going to be further seriously impaired, recently when I was away people staying at 130 used the back of the house as proposed and the noise they made on a number of nights resulted in the police being called twice as well as Camden Environment Department being contacted. The sound proofing in the house is already poor, there has usually been 2 adults &amp; 1-2 children living next to me, I have heard their conversations and arguments &amp; their screaming child through the night &amp; you make concessions for them however that's a different matter when 6 people who probably worked in restaurants arriving home at 01:30, congregating in the kitchen which was under my bedroom &amp; next to my neighbours &amp; regularly started singing badly for hours this soon became a potentially violent situation. I cannot sufficiently describe the impact of having [REDACTED] due to people's main living area being next to my bedroom but having a balcony next to my bedroom may result in me having to leave my home after 36 years.</p>

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
