REAR GARDEN: 1 x Sycamore (T24) - Fell to ground level.

The Council has considered your application dated 27 January 2022 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

1 This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.

Reason: To allow the Local planning authority to monitor the completion and standards of the work.

2 All work shall be carried out in accordance with the relevant recommendations of British Standard 3998: 2010. (Recommendation for Tree Work)

Reason: To ensure the preservation of the amenity value and health of the tree(s).

3 Between November 2022 and March 2023, a sweetgum tree (Liquidambar

styraciflua) shall be planted in the rear garden of the property as a heavy standard with a stem circumference of 14-16cm at 1m above the rootball unless otherwise agreed with the council in writing. The tree shall be planted no less than 1m from any structure and in accordance with BS8545:2014, and no more that 5m from the location of the application tree. Should the tree die or become seriously diseased within 5 years of planting it shall be replaced with a tree of the same species and size as detailed in this condition.

Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 206 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended)
