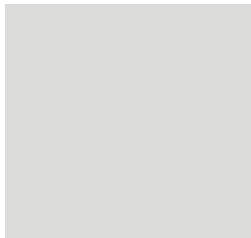


4.15 WALL 02 DETAILS: SECTION HH

To create a backdrop of the atrium building elevation which is tired and in disrepair, Wall 02 is proposed to renew this area.

It is to be formed from treated timber, 18mm ply and a light grey paint clad with a thin metal trellis to introduce greenery to site.

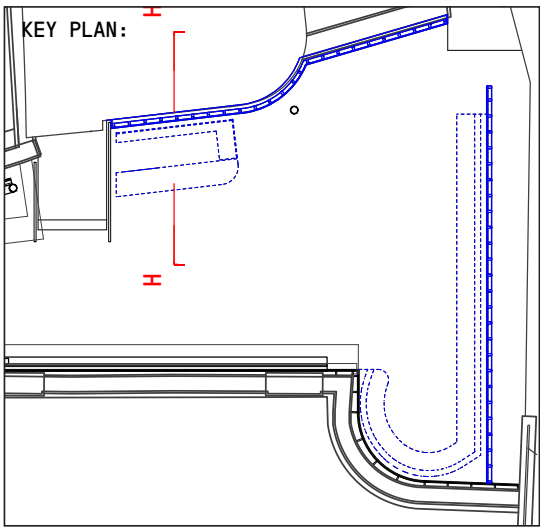






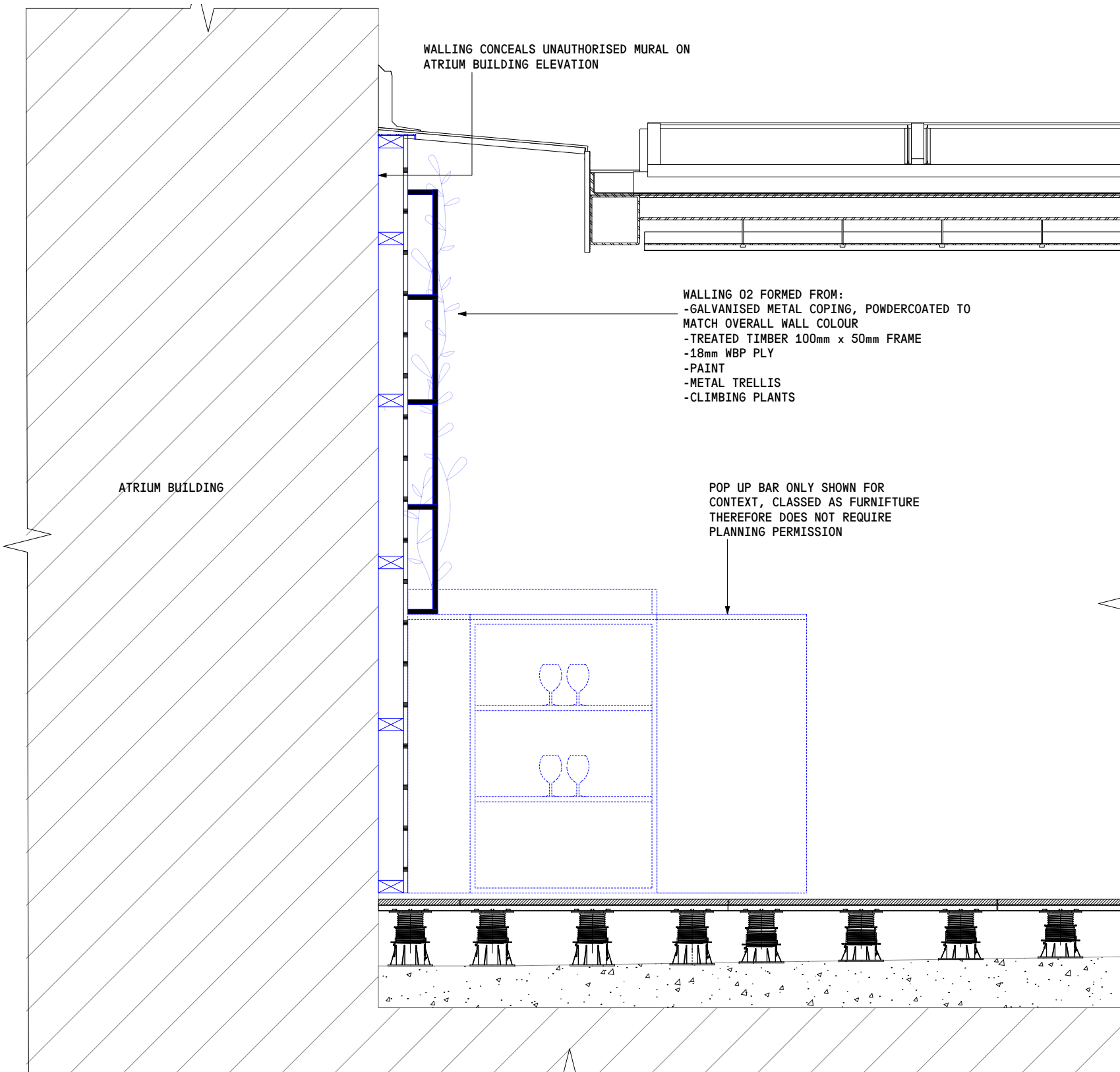

4.16 WALL 02 DETAILS: SECTION JJ

The wall is proposed to follow the shape of the flank wall elevation of the existing atrium building and continue in front of the adjoining parapet wall to enclose the terrace from the surrounding offices and units below.

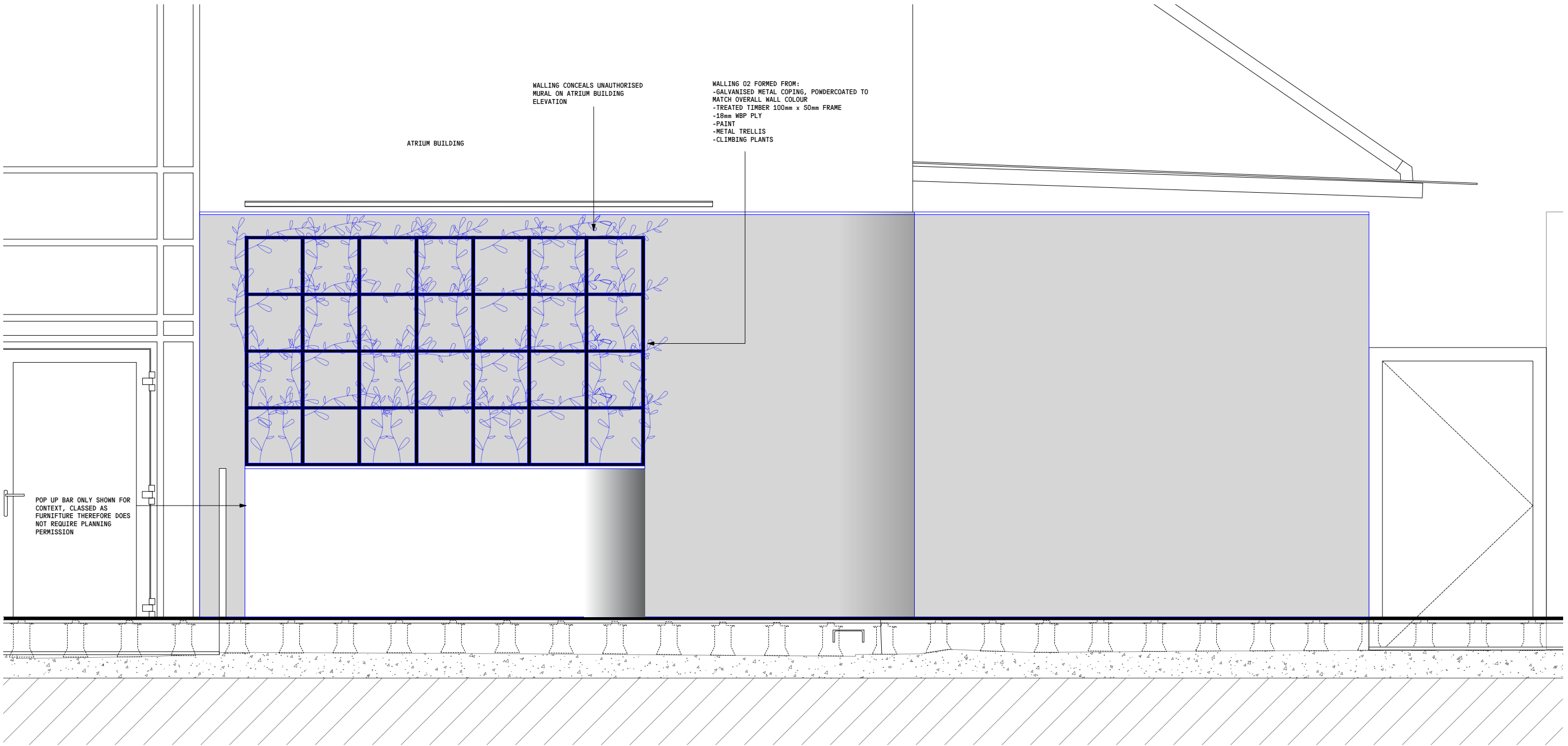
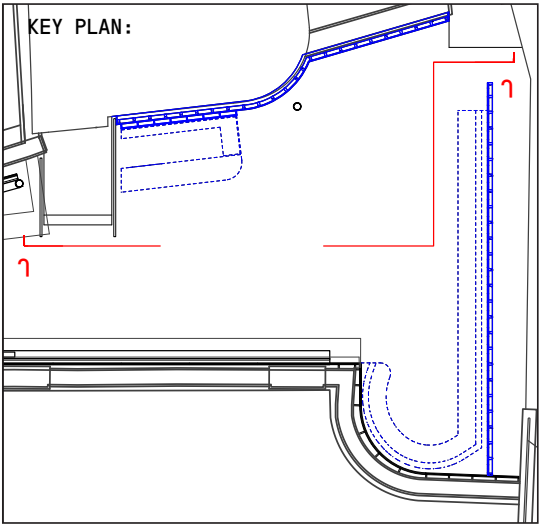
