I am a resident in Lowlands (2-8 Eton Avenue), residing in Flat 2.

I wish to record my formal objection to the planning application referred to above (re placing of a mast on top of the Lowlands building).

My reasons are as follows:

1. Eton Avenue and the surrounding areas (England's lane, Primrose Hill etc) is known for its aesthetics and beauty which brings residents and tourists to the area. A massive cell phone mast on top of Lowlands will be a complete eye sore to the area and ruin the look and feel of the area (and is completely contrary to the surroundings of the area).
