1 Reasons for granting approval-

Condition 40 requires the development to achieve a maximum internal water use of 105 litres per person per day for external water use. The submitted water efficiency calculations show a water consumption rate of 94.90 litres per person per day. As such the condition can be discharged. The water use details demonstrate that the development contributes to minimising the need for further water infrastructure in an area of water stress.
