Thank you for your email. With regards to your comments below, I can confirm the following:

- The lift structure will be mostly glazed on all sides, with the exception of some solid panels in line
 with the first floor landing (to conceal the platform when at the upper level. This is indicated on the
 submitted elevation drawings.
- We are happy to go with the dark grey colour as you suggest.
- With regards to further details of the lift structure, we would be keen to avoid conditions on any approval. Given that it has taken over 6 month to get to this point with the application, we do not want to be in a similar situation with regards to releasing conditions. The College are keen to get this health and safety concern regarding the lift resolved for the safety of the users. The College has the funds in place and is keen to get this built. With that in mind, if you can confirm what specific details you require, we can get those from the supplier and issue them as part of this approval.

In addition to your points:

- Please can you confirm if you have any comments regarding the window replacement proposals which were part of the above lift application?
- We also made a separate Listed Building Consent application regarding replacement of existing internal doors and months later we are still awaiting the decision notice. Please can you provide an update on this matter too?

Hopefully we can get these applications resolved very soon as the College are keen to undertake the works. If you require any further information please get in touch.

- The proposed colour for the lift structure frames appears out of context and makes the structure stand out.
 You are advised to change this to match the adjacent dark grey handrail and door. Can you please confirm your agreement to this? We would need further detailed drawings for the lift structure but those can be also conditioned.
