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I am writing on behalf of the Residents Association at South End Close, a community of 140 Camden council owned/leased apartments backing onto Constantine Road.

We have clearly listed our objections to any planning applications in Constantine Road which will impact upon our peace and quality of life. With the approval of this planning application (see ref above) - without conditions - South end close will once again become a building site, Storage Depot, waste disposal area, and general work site for 21 Constantine road's works.

Last time a Constantine road property build was undertaken (Apr '21) illegal access was once more made onto the estate to support works and a disabled resident of SEC was assaulted and the police had to be called to move the obstruction (truck unloading scaffolding completely blocking access to D block).

The residents of South end Close will work to maintain the dignity of their private spaces and will if any works vehicles utilise South end close as a worksite or depot request these to leave or inform the police.

Can this embargo on using the private access ways of South end close please be made clear to the owners of 21 Constantine Road?
