2. The use of the basement and ground floors shall be for Housing Aid Centre purposes only and for no other purpose. If the Housing Aid Centre vacates the property, the use of this part of the premises shall revert to shop and storage.

Reasons for conditions:

- 1. In order to safeguard the existing provision of retail facilities in the West End Lane shopping centre.
- In order to ensure that policies in respect of retail uses and local services are complied with.
