BACKGROUND

Street Art for Mankind is partnering with UN Women by creating landmark murals with prominent women street artists around the world. These murals, inaugurated with UN, city and government officials help raise awareness on the need to accelerate equality, leadership and opportunity for women and girls worldwide.

The first 3 murals, part of 2021 <u>Generation Equality Forum</u> took place in Mexico City, Paris and New York. The next mural in 2022 will take place in London

All murals of this series are connected to each other by their positive/optimistic narrative that brings together two generations of women. They symbolize the intergenerational transmission of this fight started by mothers and amplified by the next generations, while telling their own story.




GENERATION EQUALITY MURAL 2022 - SKETCH
