The Council confirms that the remedial works as described above are exempt from the need for further notifications or any formal application to the Council and you are therefore allowed to proceed.

- 1 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife. ## Conditions and Reasons:

Between November 2022 and March 2023, a Robinia pseudoacacia "Frisia" (false acacia "Frisia") tree with a stem 14-16cm in circumference at 1m above the base of the stem shall be planted in the front garden of the property. The tree shall be planted no less than 750mm from any structure and shall be planted and maintained in accordance with BS8545:2014.

Reason: In order to comply with section 206 of the Town and Country Plannning Act 1990 (as amended).
