Proposal:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Oak (T1) - Reduction of height and spread radius of up to 1.5m, focusing on selective thinning and/or reduction of regen. regrowth from previous pruning stumps, combined with selective lateral reduction of up to 2.5m targeting misshapen crown portions to the south, south-west, and north-east [see images] to balance crown. Selective removal of duplicated previous pruning-stumps in order to form idealised scaffold limb structure [see images]. Selective removal of inner crown reactive epicormic growth whilst ensuring inner crown natural growth is retained as far as possible.

The Council has considered your application dated 29 March 2022 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):
