This application would affect the quality of light to 4a, c , d, and e Gate Street as no.2 projects much further out into Whetstone Park where as we are set back along with other buildings.</p> <p>2. Loss of privacy. The view from the roof garden and proposed balconies would look directly into the upstairs bedrooms and bathroom as well as the kitchen/lounge of 4e Gate Street and any privacy barrier would further affect the light. In addition to the invasion of privacy we are also concerned about noise pollution from a roof garden as we have previously suffered from this in the area.</p> <p>A general comment would be that the proposal would spoil the cascading view of numbers 2, 4 and 6 from the street and would look out of place with the existing (including listed) buildings.</p>

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
