## Full Planning Permission Refused and Warning of Enforcement Action to be Taken

Address: 1A-1B 1 and 2 Murray Street London NW1 9RE

Proposal: Erection of metal railings on low plinth to the front area. Drawing Nos: 1163-01; 1163-03; 1163-13; Design and Access Statement dated 16.11.2021.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

#### Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The railings and associated plinths by reason of their siting, scale and design, appear as incongruous elements which result in visual clutter to the frontage and detract from the character and appearance of the application building, the terrace of buildings that it forms part of and the wider conservation area, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
