I object 5 years of heavy construction traffic moving down our street, especially when an alternative solution for the traffic has been proposed. Furthermore, as a local business owner (Redemption Roasters, 84B Lambs Conduit Street) and employer I can confidently tell you that a large scale disturbance such as the one proposed in the planning application would disrupt our business to the extent that we would have to let staff go. I hope the "archway at the end of Powis Place within the hospital grounds" alternative can be considered.
