


OVERVIEW OF SOFT LANDSCAPING: The soft landscaping has a broader mix of tree, shrub, herbaceous and groundcover, plus a natural grass lawn with shade and drought tolerant grass mix. The additional soft landscaping increases the horticultural mix from pure amenity grass to a richer mix for wildlife habitat. It is informed by policy BG1 of the Redington and Frognaal Neighbourhood Plan. It builds on and diversifies the mix of existing Sycamore, Chestnut and London Plane trees.
