I am writing to express my concern about the DECONSTRUCTION and CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT Plan which has been proposed in the ongoing debate about demolition plans for Great Ormond Street Hospital.

Nobody is denying the incredibly important work that GOSH does but the plans proposed will ensure that life will be made absolutely miserable for those who live in the Street and the surrounding areas

As a result of pollution, disruption, heavy traffic and the felling of trees which soak up pollution will ironically affect the health of young children and their families.

There is a solution in "The Archway Plan" – an Archway at the end of Powis Place which would reduce traffic and disruption considerably.
