I object on the grounds that this plan appears to take absolutely no consideration of those who live and work in the neighbourhood. This includes hundreds of local children.

By these current plans, all our lives will be severely impacted for up to five years and I am shocked by the lack of consideration for local residents prior this application being submitted.

Hours: These are extremely open-ended with works potentially being carried on at any hour and on any day with almost no protections. This includes anticipated noisy and high-level vibrations works.

Transport Management: or the lack of one ...Where is a full transport assessment?? Current plans take absolutely no consideration of the level of traffic already in the streets that will be affected by flows of highly polluting and dangerous HGV lorries for 5 long years. This is when alternative routes could and should be considered.

Cycle Lane Disruption: What route do they suggest cyclists use given the level of construction/construction vehicles? Is their safety being taken into account?

Traffic management: any consideration for local children having walk to school in these highly congested and polluting mess they will be inflicting?
