The NNA covers Maresfield Gardens, Netherhall Gardens and Nutley Terrace.</p> <p>We support the objection made by HCAAC on 8 June and agree entirely with their three grounds of submissions.</p> <p>We would like to make three additional comments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The applicant's reasons for requesting variation are risible - in particular, the argument that providing 5 charging points is 'very beneficial to not overload the community resources' (i.e. the current low number of public chargers in the area).</li><li>- The changes made to the front garden and boundary walls are exactly the kind of development that the proposed Article 4 direction, shortly to be consulted on, is intended to eliminate.</li><li>- The changes create a danger to the public, particularly school children, walking past the front garden because of cars crossing.</li></ul> <p>For all these reasons, we urge the planning officer to resist this retrospective application.</p> <p>Kind regards Jenny White Chair, NNA</p>
