This application relates only to the upper floors (Flat B) of 79 Arlington Road. The proposal involves the removal of the existing roof structure, which consists three mono-pitched roofs sloping towards a valley gutter in the middle of the roof. The proposal will form a new attic storey with a mansard roof to front and rear elevations, creating a bedroom and a shower room. The proposed mansard at No.79 will match the proportions and materials of all the neighbouring property. The proposal will be one of several similar mansard roof extensions in the surrounding streets.

The proposal involves the removal of the existing roof structure, which consists three mono-pitched roofs sloping towards a valley gutter in the middle of the roof. The main roof, while mimicking the traditional butterfly, was extensively repaired and replaced by previous owners nearly 40 years ago. Consequently many of the original features are long gone. Some of the original timbers were reused, but most are new, and the original slates were replaced long ago with concrete ones.

The intervention aims to create a more coherent design, improve the internal circulation and maximise the internal space to improve the usability and liveability of this flat for a young family. At present the family have outgrown the size of the flat and due to the unavailability of appropriate and affordable comparable housing stock in the local area, their best option is to seek permission to extend their existing dwelling.
