Reason(s) for Objection

1 The proposed rooftop equipment, notably the central tower mast with antennas, by reason of its location, height, design and scale, would result in overly dominant visual rooftop clutter and would cause harm to the character and appearance of the host property, streetscene and key viewpoints within the surrounding Hatton Garden Conservation Area. The proposal would therefore be contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraph 38 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2021.
