The submission includes a dismantling and storage report prepared by London Stone Conservation together with a task briefing sheet detailing how the listed drinking fountain would be removed and stored off-site. The agent has

confirmed that the fountain has already been removed and has been placed in storage. This part of the condition can therefore be discharged.

The condition also requires it to include a method statement for the cleaning and reinstatement of the fountain. The method statement for reinstatement could not be completed until the dismantling had been undertaken and the structure could be understood more fully. The details relating to this part of the condition remain outstanding/reserved and further details will be required to be submitted regarding any cleaning of the fountain and its relocation to its new location in front of the Shaftesbury Theatre.

On this basis, the details relating to the dismantling and storage of the drinking fountain are considered to be in accordance with policy D2 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

You are reminded that conditions 4 (method statement for cleaning and reinstatement) and condition 5 (connection to water mains method statement) of listed building consent 2020/1446/L dated 23/02/2021 are outstanding and require details to be submitted and approved.
