
Hope you're well.

If this is an issue, then we will not increase the overall height of the outbuilding, we will reduce the internal head height only (keeping overall height as per issued planning drawings).

Of course, we would prefer to increase overall height by 150-200mm, but not at the risk of a rejected application.

One question, what is the height of the void beneath the slab, just need to confirm if this will result in the outbuilding being taller and by how much?

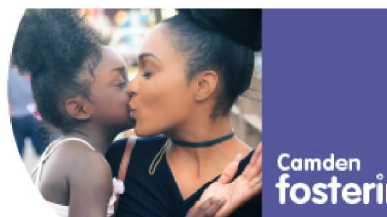
