The obscured glazing to the rear windows was, with the set back of the upper storey, a reasonable mitigation of the overlooking from the new houses of the habitable rooms in Gloucester Avenue. The present proposal weakens this mitigation by effectively moving the set back closer to the Gloucester Avenue houses, would allow use of the flat roof by residents, and further undermine the protection afforded by the obscure glazing to the rear elevation of the mews houses. This would be harmful to the amenity of the dwellings in Gloucester Avenue. It is critical for the character and appearance of the conservation area that new development respects the amenity of residents, and is not subsequently undermined: back-land development is characteristic of the CA but needs to respect the amenity of existing residents.
