About the role

You will lead Camden's Climate Change Alliance business network over the next 8 months overseeing the delivery of our new GLA funded Business Climate Challenge project. The Business Climate Challenge project will involve working with Business Improvement Districts to identify over 50 businesses for energy efficiency audits and supporting them to identify finance to deliver the recommended building improvements.

You will also oversee the delivery of a new "Climate Connectors" project which will match businesses with community groups and schools to direct private investment towards local environmental projects.

Alongside these two key projects, you will also oversee the Climate Change Alliance's engagement and communications strategy, including hosting events, publishing newsletters, and building and maintaining relationships with new and existing Climate Change Alliance members and support for schools in delivery to schools.
