I support Camlins's Landscape Management Plan, as I did the earlier versions. Also the vital 24 month proposed maintenance of their plantings. They give details of their tree plantings, including the Courtyard *Liriodendron* (Tulip tree), the hybrid elm (*Ulmus lutece*) to replace the felled Plane, the *Liquidambar styraciflua* (*Sweet Gum*) at the bottom of Bertram Street and those at the rear community garden of the Pentad in Winscombe Street. Other examples are 266 Privet hedging plants and various shrubs and herbaceous plants such as Clematis, Hydrangea, Jasmine, Lavender, Philadelphus and Carex.

I also support the green roof planting and maintenance and also the more recent additions of Swift, Robin, bat bricks and invertebrate boxes to encourage various fauna into the Community.
