## Highgate CAAC has made the following comment:

# Summary of representations

"Highgate CAAC notes the tree protection plan and the arboricultural report submitted but is concerned that no account is taken of the importance of the boundary trees in screening the site from the listed Waterlow Park. If the trees suffer harm the fact that the application is for temporary buildings will be irrelevant. More account also should be taken of the potential for damage to trees actually in the Park. We also feel that the 18 month schedule must be adhered to with no allowance for an extension."

#### Officer comment:

The proposed temporary buildings would not be sited near Waterlow Park, which is to the north of the hospital campus. The temporary buildings are

proposed in the south-western corner of the hospital site.

Nevertheless, an Arboricultural Assessment and method statement for tree protection have been submitted and the Council's Tree Officer is satisfied with these subject to the suggested conditions.

Recommendation: Grant planning permission
