BS 5837:2012 TREE RETENTION CATEGORIES

Category A

Trees of high quality with an estimated remaining life expectancy of at least 40 years.

Category B

Trees of moderate quality with an estimated remaining life expectancy of at least 20 years.

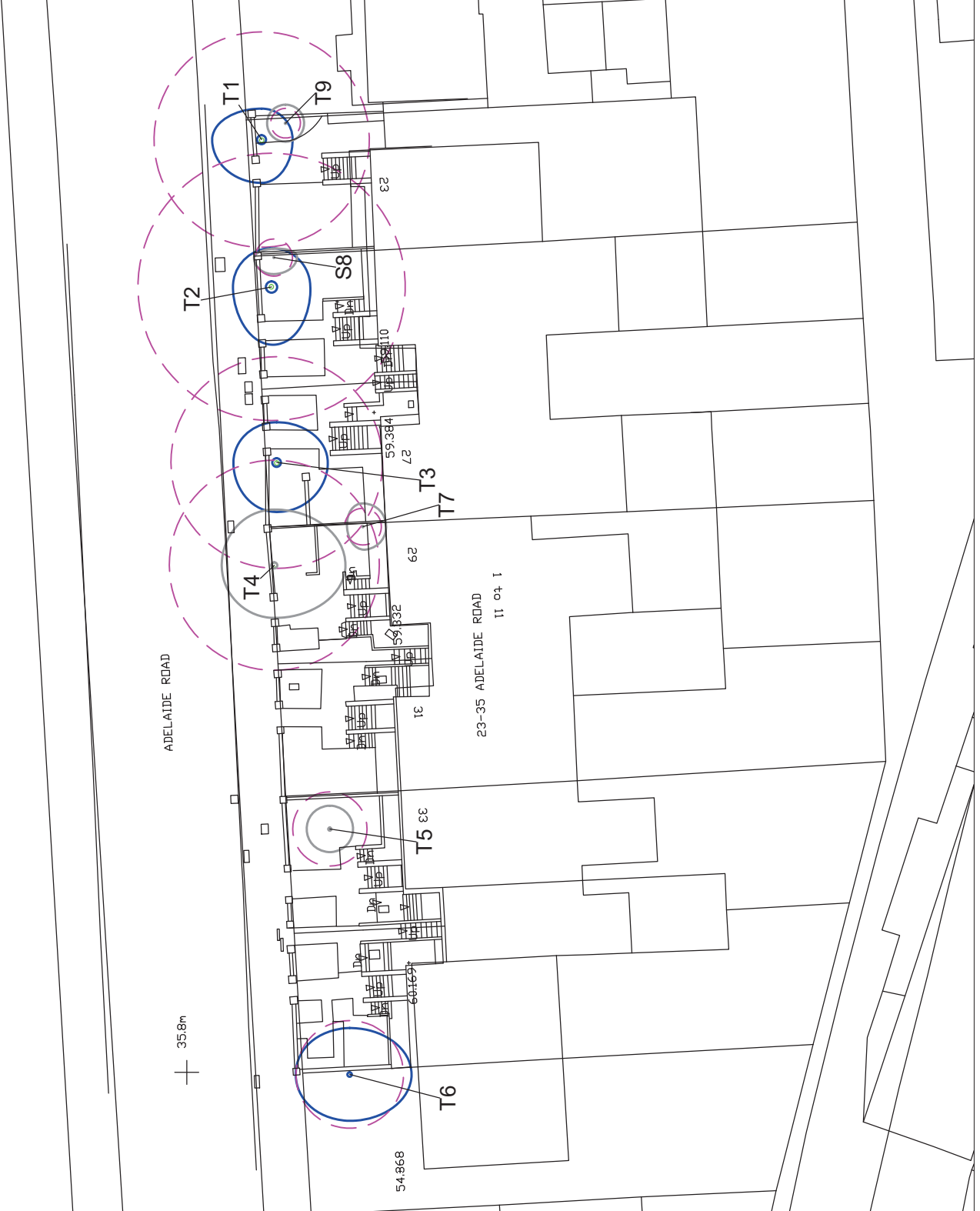
Category C

Trees of low quality with an estimated remaining life expectancy of at least 10 years & young trees with a stem diameter less than 150mm.

Category U

These in such a condition that the tree cannot realistically be retained as living trees in the context of the current land use for longer than 10 years.

**BS5837 Root Protection Areas**  
 Areas around trees which tree roots and soil structure must be protected. All works within these areas will require special methods of work.
