Proposal:

Removal of front planter and hardstanding to create vehicular access and onsite parking with vehicular crossover.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposal would result in the loss of front garden space and part of the front boundary wall, which contributes to the character and appearance of the conservation area, and as such, would be harmful to the character and appearance of the streetscene and the wider Redington Frognal Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017 and policies SD1 (Refurbishment of existing building stock), SD2 (Redington Frognal Conservation Area), SD4 (Redington Frognal Character), BGI1 (Gardens and Ecology) of Redington Frognal Neighbourhood Plan 2021. 2 The creation of an on-site parking space would promote the use of private motor vehicles, fail to encourage the use of sustainable modes of transport and result in the loss of on-street parking in the surrounding area, contrary to policies T1 (Prioritising walking, cycling and public transport), T2 (Parking and car free development) and A1 (Managing the impact of development) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
