



Brief on maintenance for M-Trays

Although Sedum is a hardy species, it pays to look after your M-Tray®. It's a bit of the old adage "you get out, what you put in".

We use eleven different species of sedum that provide, texture, colour and flowering. Because it is a living thing, it will change over the seasons and really come into it's own in the Spring & Summer months. So follow these simple steps to get the most out of your Modular Green Roof;

1. At the end of Summer the flowering that you have seen in pinks, whites and yellow will start to die off. Using your hand as a rake, clear the dead stalks and flowering away. By not doing this, the dead matter blocks the sun to the healthy Sedum and creates bald patches. Also weed out obvious grass that can come from wind and birds. With this done, scatter some of our fertiliser (A 900gram bag is good for approximately 20 to 30sqm) and water in.
2. In early Spring, Once again, weed any obvious grass and clear dead matter such as leaves and fertilise again.
3. Watering – Sedum will typically last 6 weeks without rain, but just like a human who could survive three days without water, it's not the ideal or healthiest thing to do. As a general rule, if we haven't had rain in a two week period, give your green roof a water.
4. If you live in an area with lots of trees you are going to get more leaves and matter on your green roof. Try to get on your roof four times a year to clear this away.
5. Bald Patches – If you forget to carry out maintenance or you notice bald patches, you can simply take some sedum out of a strong growing area and push into these patches. Give it a water and they will normally take root in 3-4 weeks.
