The tree forms a very important part of the streetscape and public amenity in this part of Compayne Gardens and the South Hampstead Conservation Area. It is also noted that in 2016 an application for emergency works to reduce the tree by 40% was made but there appears to be have been no decision taken on these works by Camden and work was not undertaken.
				CRASH accepts that the tree is not in a very healthy condition however it is dense with vegetation - it is covered in ivy due to lack of regular maintenance of the tree and the accompanying tree report to this application (and photo in 2016 application) indicates decay of the base of the tree.
				Given the TPO in place and the very important part of the streetscape this tree forms CRASH requests that Camden objects to the application as submitted. If Camden's officers concur with the tree report, a corrected application noting the TPO status should be submitted with a commitment to replant a mature tree - CRASH requests that any forthcoming decision requires the replanting of a mature tree (several metres tall and girth) of the same/similar variety ie robinia.
