At that time it still had the appearance of a coach house, annex to St. John's Lodge with the addition of a glazed top floor that attached it to the main house. There was also the addition of a glaze-roofed "studio" at the rear for a sculptor who had lived there previously. Apart from these additions it was still a simple looking brick house set back and lower than the streetscape. The alterations in the 90's were unsympathetic and it will be good to see them go.
