Regarding the front garden of the above property, a large tree was already removed from the front garden and all the plant borders stripped. This happened overnight, without any of the correct permissions sought. It happened before building work began. It was shocking to all the neighbours and was raised with the council at the time, to no effect.

The current photos and details represent the property after this had already happened, and so present a false picture and do little to compensate for the loss of greenery and privacy that the original garden offered. The tiny tree proposed should be replaced by a much more substantial tree to keep the character of the street and gardens, as it was before the owners removed it without permission. The garden area, likewise, should not be compromised to have double parking, which is completely inconsistent with other properties in Pilgrim's Lane, especially on this very narrow bottle-neck end of the road, which is one-way and quickly congested.

It clearly goes against the character of the street and precedent, and is unnecessary.

I have tried to put my comments through on the Camden planning applications website, but found it impossible today, and so I am submitting it as email and would appreciate confirmation.
