## Schedule 17 Consultation under the High Speed 2 (London – West Midlands) Act 2017

### EUSTON CAVERN HEADHOUSE

*Application for approval under Schedule 17 of High Speed Rail (London - West Midlands) Act 2017 relating to vent shaft headhouse building, comprising of one headhouse building, planter boxes, earthworks to include hardstanding area for vehicle access to the site and vehicle parking, access gates, , parapet wall and artificial lighting equipment affixed to the headhouse building and within the compound.*
