2022/2378/P	K P GAN	15/08/2022 22:44:49	OBJ	<p>RE: OBJECTION INSTALLATION --- more than four times of application</p> <p>I strongly object for the following points below:</p> <p>1) I don't want huge and weight equipments (6 x antenna apertures, 2 x transmission dishes and 8 x equipment cabinets & ancillary works) put on top of the roof and fixing uncountable large poles would cause permanent damage to the roof structural stability.</p> <p>I am on the top floor, exactly just under the roof and sleep under the masts, and it less than 3 meter.</p> <p>My entrance door frame, living room door frame and bath room door frame had shifted because too much demolition works, excavation and pilling work surrounding.</p> <p>2) Soundproof between roof and my ceiling is very poor, I can hear noise from steel elements when is windy; when strong wind I can hear wind noise sound through my ceiling; when maintenance crew carry work on the roof, I even can hear they are talking when they are on roof edge which above my window. (even though window is close).</p> <p>There is no independent access to the roof, maintenance crew need to walk up through the floor to gain access to the roof, which will be at the top floor, is too much traffic and noise.</p> <p>3) I don't want to live under all kind of steelwork, wire and equipments (Huma Rights Act (1998) (HRA1998); Article 8 (right to respect for private and family life); Article 1 of the First Protocol (protection of property enjoy your property peacefully).</p> <p>I have nothing against technological advancements and innovation in telecommunications, but this base station is highly unsuitable for residential building.</p>

In addition, I don't see a valid reason to place the proposed equipment on top of the apartment building when there are many commercial buildings around, which are not primary residences for 100 or more people!</p>

2022/2378/P	Mr Martys	15/08/2022 22:41:02	OBJ	<p>As a resident who lives on the top floor directly under where the antennas will be placed I object for the following reasons: (1) According to the ICNIRP safeguards each antenna should output only 1 tenth of the maximum allowance of electromagnetic radiation. By installing 6 antennae in close proximity, the increase of radiation exposure will exceed the ICNIRP limit. This is even greater than the ICNIRP limit when considering that there is already several other strong 5G signals in the local area. (2) The soundproofing between the top floor flat and the roof is very poor. There is already too much traffic on the roof, the noise of which already disturbs me. I do not want this to be added to, even fractionally. (3) This is a residential building in central London in a highly dense built-up area containing an estimated 80% non-residential commercial building. I object to our residential building used as a platform for the antennae instead of a commercial one. (4) No matter what the applicants say, the antenna's etc will look unsightly, not matter what colour they are. (5) There have been repeated attempts to gain permission to instal antennas etc on my roof, this is now feeling like bullying and harassment - keep applying till I give up objecting. (6) As a resident, I received no information about this current application and only just found out today via a neighbour - as someone directly affected, curtesy would suggest that I should have been directly contacted about the application with information on how to object.</p>
