The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

- The change of use, in the absence of sufficient justification demonstrating that the basement premises is no longer suitable for continued business use, would fail to support economic activity in Camden and would result in the loss of employment opportunities within the Borough, contrary to policy E2 (employment premises and sites) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
- The use of the premises as a bar, by reason of the nature of the use, access and location adjacent to residential properties results in noise, nuisance and disturbance in the area to the detriment of the amenity of residents of adjoining and neighbouring properties. The proposal is therefore contrary to policy A1 (Managing the impacts of development) and policy TC2 (Camden's Centres and other shopping areas) of the

London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.
