#### Officer response:

Summary of representations

1. The two illuminated signs are static, with suitably low luminance levels, at 300cd/m2. The signs will be facing Greenwood Place and sit at a comfortable distance from the opposite blocks. As such, the signage would not adversely affect any neighbouring amenity, particularly given that the signs will not be facing Highgate Road, but are situated on Greenwood Place.
