Bartholomew Estate and Kentish Town CAAC has reviewed the above application and would like to object on the grounds that the proposed changes are not in keeping with the surrounding buildings which are part of the CAAC . The proposals are too large do not include materials in keeping with a conservation area e.g metal window frames and the apparent painting of the flank wall which currently is of london stock which is the material of the majority of the adjacent buildings.. The taller proposals will change the current roof line in relation to Leverton place .and will have ' an adverse effect on the skyline (BE 16) The proposed demolition of a wall between 1-3 Leverton Street which is part of a listed building The Bartholomew Estate area statement BE14 states * the demolition of listed buildings will be resisted " we feel this includes this wall .
