1 Reasons for approval-

Condition 4 requires details of the green roof for the approved outbuilding to be submitted and approved. Specifically the details should include a scheme of maintenance, sections at a scale of 1:20 with manufactures details demonstrating the construction and materials used and substrate depth and finally full details of planting species.

The details of a sedum roof demonstrate that it will be designed to enhance the

biodiversity of the site and will attenuate surface water to some degree. The details are considered sufficient to discharge the condition and is recommended for approval.
