It is proposed to construct an additional storey on the existing residential property at 126 King Henry's Road, London NW3 3SN, in line with the standards set out within Class AA, Schedule 2, Part 1 of the GPDO. The proposed additional storey would be constructed on the principal part of the existing house.

The additional storey would accommodate a master bedroom with an en-suite bathroom, a study, a laundry and an extra bathroom. In line with the requirements, no windows will be located on the side elevations of the additional storey. Additional windows will be located in the front and rear elevations in order to provide the new rooms with good level of light. The total height of the additional storey, at approximately 2.9 metres, falls well within the parameters set by the Guidance.

Please describe the effects of the proposed development on the external appearance of the building including the design and architectural features of the principal elevation (and any side elevation that fronts a highway)

As shown on the accompanying drawings, the materials for the additional storey have been carefully selected in order to match the materials of the existing house. The brickwork and render have been designed to match the existing materials.

The additional storey, once constructed, will appear as a natural extension to the existing building and not as a separate element.
