PRIMROSE HILL CONSERVATION AREA ADVISORY COMMITTEE 12A Manley Street London NW1 8LT 7 September 2022 Railway Bridge Parkway NW1 2022/3530/P Objection. We note that, as the applicant states, under Condition A2 of Part 18 of Class A of the GPDO 2015 prior approval can be refused if 'the design or external appearance would injure the amenity of the neighbourhood and is reasonably capable of modification so as to avoid such injury.' The Committee advises that the proposed use of a GRP coping in the Conservation Area would be harmful to the character and appearance of the conservation area. It is an unacceptable material in terms of its appearance and weathering characteristics in a conservation area. It would neither preserve nor enhance the character and appearance of the conservation area. The conservation area has many examples of boundary walls in stock brick with various traditional forms of coping which would enable this injury to be avoided. We also advise that the visual amenity of the conservation area requires that the brick used in raising the wall matches the existing, and that the pointing is
