The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** a certificate of lawfulness for the following reason:

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The evidence provided is not sufficiently precise and unambiguous to demonstrate, on the balance of probability, that the 3 x air conditioning units located at the side of the property have been present at the site for a continuous

period of 4 years or more prior to the date that an enforcement notice (EN19/0638) was served on the 22/09/2020, as required under the Act. Additionally, the Council has evidence which contradicts and undermines the applicant's version of events.
