## Ref: Existing beech trees along the retaining wall between 28/30 Redington Road at rear garden side

Following a visual assessment of the existing trees and adjacent retaining wall structure carried out by Symmetrys on September 16<sup>th</sup> 2022, we can confirm that the beech trees (marked T7, T8 and T9 in the Arboricultural Impact Assessment ref: 20–3472) have caused damage to the retaining wall.

Based on the information provided by Shaun Phillips, Arboriculturist at Nicholsons Lockhart Garratt, we can confirm that the potential growth of the trees is likely to further damage the retaining wall structure in the future.
