This is with reference to the captioned planning application I am a resident of flat 3 in Barrie house and I would strongly oppose this for the following reasons 1. Barrie house has is a building from 1950s and as a result of this the impact of structural changes on the old building are not known 2. The building has faced challenges in recent times with gas supply and heating and the inmates had to make several escalations to the landlord and even then the issues are not fully resolved 3. The landlord is trying to build additional apartments in the parking lot and the impact of such construction on Barrie house have also not been transparently discussed or assessed 4. There is a discussion on move from communal heating to individual heating however how the existing communal heating will be changed to individual heating has not been defined or discussed 5. The lift remains out of service very often and this has caused serious inconvenience to several elderly inmates of the block Given the existing challenges faced by the inmates on basic living conditions, increasing the stress on building with additional construction would make things worse

I would strongly oppose the application and would implore to the council to take some actions to improve the living conditions in the building
