


Flooding has caused water ingress and damp problems in the front room. CDA intends to repair and carefully restore the room.





The existing platform will be removed. CDA believes that this design clarifies the layout of the lower ground floor and improves the circulation of the space.






PROPOSED INFILL

Design Intent


As seen in the side elevations, the proposed extension is lightweight and it sits sympathetically alongside the more robust brick of the host building. The windows in the outrigger will be infilled. The door on the ground floor will be wider, which better suites the master bedroom space. The door on the lower ground floor will be infilled. These design decisions make the master bedroom and dining room spaces in the extension have clean elevations that read clearly as a modern extension that is subservient to the original building.

CDA is also proposing that photo voltaic panels and a roof light are placed on the extension roof. CDA is also proposing that the existing side door at the front of the house be replaced with new semi-glazed door that matches those of adjacent properties.

The use of contrasting materials to the main house is intended so it may be read as a separate element to the dominant structure and not detract from the pr operty's original form. CDA intends the extension to be of light weight glazed infill panels encased in a slim profile, aluminium frame finished in gun-metal.




Design Intent



Proposed Rear Elevation




Proposed Glazing Detail (A-A)


