I object to the planning application 2022/3289/P being granted as follows:

The indications are that extensive use will be made of the terrace by the applicants during the day, evening and weekends which would have a great impact upon the peace, privacy, wellbeing and enjoyment of my home and all the other residents in Beaconsfield, not to mention the extreme close proximity of bedroom windows and walls to the proposed application.

This would create enormous antisocial behaviour and in addition would be a security risk and a fire risk which would put the lives of all the residents in Beaconsfield at risk.

In addition, the wellbeing, peace, privacy and security of all of residents in Beaconsfield would be diminished and will cause immense distress to residents. This application must be refused and not be allowed to go ahead.
